Congratulations on your quest for college! We want to help you reach your goal. Dan Camilliere was a US Army WWII Veteran who served his Country, State, and Wethersfield with distinction and honor. His life epitomized "Service above Self." We're looking to recognize two Wethersfield seniors who exemplify "Service above Self" with a \$500 scholarship.

Criteria:

- 1) Complete the application including an unofficial transcript from your high school.
- 2) Be able to articulate in a 3-to-5-minute video essay how you served our community during your high school years.
- 3) Be a Wethersfield resident or attend Wethersfield High School.
- 4) The scholarship award must be used for the academic year beginning in the fall of 2025.
- 5) A personal interview may be requested in front of the Dan Camilliere Scholarship Committee.
- 6) Email application and video essay to veteranscommission@wethersfield.gov by April 30, 2025. The scholarship will be awarded on June 2, 2025, at the Town Council Meeting.

There will be two winners of the Dan Camilliere Scholarship Award of \$500 each to be used towards college costs in the fall of 2025. College can include a community college, four-year college, and technical or vocational school. The deadline for submission is April 30, 2025. The Dan Camilliere Scholarship Committee will review all submissions, ensuring compliance with the above criteria and collectively decide on the winning recipient. The award recipient will be notified in writing and a courtesy phone call at the number provided on the application.
