

Wethersfield Veterans Day Ceremony 11:00AM - 12:00PM, Friday, November 10, at Wethersfield High School

Veterans Day falls on Saturday this year, so the annual ceremony honoring the town's many veterans will occur on Friday, November 10. The ceremony will be held at the traditional time, 11:00AM, marking the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month when the armistice was signed, ending WWI. Join fellow veterans, students and community members in front of Wethersfield High School for this inspiring program. In the event of inclement weather the ceremony will be held indoors in the high school auditorium.



A HELPFUL VA BENEFIT: IN CASE YOU DON'T KNOW.....

Eligible veterans and caregivers can receive **travel pay reimbursement** for mileage and other travel expenses to and from approved health care appointments; that is, a VA health facility or for VA-approved care at a non-VA health facility in your community.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1) You have a VA disability rating of 30% or higher, **or**
- 2) You are traveling for treatment of a service-connected condition, even if your disability rating is less than 30%, **or**
- 3) You receive a VA pension, or
- 4) You have an income that is below the maximum annual VA pension rate, **or**
- 5) You can't afford to pay for your travel, as defined by the guidelines, **or**
- 6) You are traveling for one of these reasons: a scheduled VA claim exam or for VA-approved transplant care.

For caregivers, transportation and related lodging and meals may be reimbursed if the person meets any of these requirements:

- The person is the veteran's family caregiver under the National Caregiver Program traveling to receive caregiver training or to support the veteran's care, or
- 2) The person is the veteran's medically required attendant traveling with the veteran to support his/her care, **or**
- 3) The person is the veteran's transplant care donor or support person.

A REMINDER: Town of Wethersfield Tax Exemptions for Veterans

Veterans exemptions are available to Wethersfield residents as of the October 1st assessment date for those who served during one of the state mandated dates of war or military campaigns as well as received an Honorable Discharge. Your DD214 must be filed with the Town Clerk's Office by September 30th.

Exemptions are based on certain qualifying conditions, with additional benefits granted to Veterans with a VA disability rating or low income that meets State mandated income limits (proof is required). Deceased Veterans spouses will continue to receive benefits until re-marriage. Additionally, if you are a CT resident on Active Duty, you may be eligible for the total exemption of one passenger motor vehicle.
