WETHERSFIELD MEMORIAL DAY PARADE SATURDAY, MAY 24, 2025 GENERAL INFORMATION

Starting time is 9:00 a.m.

LINE OF MARCH

Will begin at 8:15 a.m. in the parking lot at the Department of Motor Vehicles on State Street. Your organization's name will be posted in the area you are to assemble in.

Marchers will be lined up on the grassy area between the DMV and the Solomon Welles House. Vehicles and floats will be lined up in the DMV parking lot and on State Street. GET THERE EARLY - Beginning at 8:30 a.m., only parade traffic will be allowed from Hartford Avenue to State Street. Shortly before the parade is to begin, traffic will be closed off on State Street from both directions and access to the Line of March by vehicle will be prohibited.

Parking at the Department of Motor Vehicles will be for those marching only. Those who are simply dropping off individuals who are marching are asked to drop them off and then proceed to the exit. Buses and trailers will be directed to the rear parking lot of the DMV. Buses may pick up marchers at the conclusion of the parade at the First Church of Christ parking lot located on Main Street at the far side of the cemetery.

NEW PARADE ROUTE 2025!! (See map on second sheet)

The parade will step off promptly at 9:00 a.m. and will head west on State Street to Nott Street then to Garden Street. We will proceed down Garden Street, cross over Church Street and proceed on Garden Street to Main Street. The parade will turn left onto Main Street and continue to Hartford Avenue where the parade will end. The Reviewing Stand will be on Main Street at the intersection of Main Street and Church Street. Any marchers not staying for the Memorial Day Ceremony can either follow the sidewalk on Hartford Avenue back to State Street or follow the sidewalk on Main Street back to State Street.

MEMORIAL DAY CEREMONY ON MAIN STREET NEW 2025

At the conclusion of the parade, a Memorial Day Ceremony will be held in front of First Church of Christ. The Reviewing Stand will serve as the stage for the ceremony. The ceremony is expected to begin at approximately 10:00am. Guest speakers and parade guests will commemorate the day.

RAIN PLANS

In case of rain, the ceremony will take place at Wethersfield High School, 411 Wolcott Hill Road at 10:00 am. A decision to move indoors will be made by 8:00 a.m. on the morning of the parade.
